Coaches' Update

Coaches consider adjusting next year schedule for water polo and swim team, not offering swim for the first 9 weeks of school and allow swimmers only after water polo season; this gives a break to club swimmers from HS swimming and practice with their clubs only; coaches extended proposal to the HS principal Russell, pending response early January – before next year class schedule goes out.

Swimmers would take the first 9 weeks other class / Senior in, and after that elect swimming

Swim meets would start in October

Any water polo athletes who are not be coming back to swimming after their season is over, would not have to pay booster dues

Treasurer update

Bob handed out up-to date financials: budget and income & expense report as of 11/30/2023 There are 20 athletes who have not paid yet, however dues are optional and athletes cannot be harassed We made \$900 profit on t-shirts, \$3,200 made on TISCA – still not collected.
